ART Portfolio Guidelines

(This is separate from Photography portfolios)

- ✓ Open to students graduating in 2008 who plan to attend college. Use portfolio entry form. One portfolio entry per student.
- ✓ This year, art portfolios are to be **submitted ONLY in slide form or jpeg.** JPEG images must be at least 300 dpi and able to be viewed on either a PC or MAC. JPEG images must be simply presented, no Power Points or colored backgrounds. Images that have been digitally enhanced will not be judged and the entire portfolio will be disqualified.
- ✓ A portfolio consists of eight works, including at least three drawings. These eight works should be exemplary examples of the students' skills and creativity.
- ✓ Portfolio entries must include a completed entry form and inventory of works.
- ✓ Each inventory sheet must have the images labeled with name, title, description, media and size.
- ✓ Portfolios will be judged using a rubric and gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the top portfolios in art. There may also be opportunities for scholarships.
- ✓ Portfolio entries must include a letter of recommendation from one of your art teachers.
- ✓ Transcripts from your high school
- ✓ A personal statement/letter that tells something about yourself, why you chose the artwork you sent and your experience with art. This letter should also include your goals regarding how art will be included in your life.
- ✓ Please package each portfolio individually with the name of the school, art teacher, student name, and media clearly marked on the outside. These can be sent in the same box with other entries for the individual competition.
- ✓ It is important that you follow the entry materials guidelines in the presenting and packaging of entries.

Photography Portfolio Guidelines

- ✓ Open to students graduating in 2008 who plan to attend college. Use portfolio entry form. One photography portfolio entry per student.
- ✓ This year, photography portfolios are to be **submitted with ONLY original photographs.**
- ✓ A portfolio consists of eight works. These eight works should be exemplary examples of the students' skills and creativity.
- ✓ All prints must be mounted rigid board and easily removable from a portfolio case.
- ✓ Portfolio entries must include a completed entry form and inventory of works. Each print must be identified with name, school and title.
- ✓ Each inventory sheet must have the images labeled with name, title, description, media and size. There may also be opportunities for scholarships.
- ✓ Portfolios will be judged using a rubric and gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the top portfolios in art.
- ✓ Portfolio entries must include a letter of recommendation from one of your art teachers.
- ✓ Transcripts from your high school
- ✓ A personal statement/letter that tells something about yourself, why you chose the artwork you sent and your experience with art. This letter should also include your goals regarding how art will be included in your life.
