1. Artwork may be submitted by instructors from public and private schools, private studios, museum programs and similar programs.
2. Maximum of two works of art per instructor by two different students.
3. No frames. Work should be mounted or matted on a firm board.
4. Send, or deliver, artwork in a **REUSABLE and secure container**.
5. Complete the following documents and place in an envelope;
 - One YAM Entry Form
 - Artwork Labels (affixed to lower right corner of art)
 - DBAE Lesson Description (affixed to lower left corner of art)
 - Artist signature somewhere on artwork
 - \$15.00 Processing Fee for Non- NATA members payable to NATA
 - Return Address label (affixed at NDE upon opening your container)
